Requirements

1. Completed, thoughtfully answered application form - including the signed commitment form - to the youth group pastoral staff by **Sunday, April 24**.

If the questions are not answered thoughtfully, you will be asked to redo your application or your application will be rejected.

The pastoral staff will read over the applications and prayerfully select students for the team. Not all applicants may be selected, as spaces are limited.

2. Mandatory attendance to Sunday service and small group. RESt attendance highly recommended.
3. You will be allowed to miss a **maximum of two** training sessions for a legitimate reason, as considered by the pastoral staff.

If you miss more than two training sessions, for whatever reason, you will be removed from the team.

If you are **late to more than three** training sessions, you will be removed from the team. (This means more than 15 minutes late.)

The dates for the training sessions will be TBA.

4. There is a very high standard for students attending summer missions. We expect that all students will be committed disciples of Jesus Christ, who are serious about their spiritual growth and are intentional about living out their faith daily.

We ask that you sincerely reflect and pray about your convictions and motivations for attending a summer mission trip.
